Beaver First Nation is looking for Hunters and Fishermen to go out on the Land. Our Communities must come together and support each other at this very tough time. We are looking for experienced individuals to support our community's food security. This initiative will be ongoing until a time we are all safe from the CORVID-19 Pandemic.

Beaver First Nation will support Hunters and Fisherman from the Community with

- Ammunition: Will be given out from BFN.
- Fuel: P.O for Cha Services from BFN.
- Basic Sustenance (Grub Box): P.O for Independent from BFN.
- Honorarium: Will be given if successful in returning with meat.

We are respectfully asking for the following

- Fish
- Moose
- Elk
- Ducks (Seasonal)
- Geese (Seasonal)
- Chickens

ALL SAFETY PRECAUTIONS ARE EXPECTED.

We ask that our hunters practice Natural Law when hunting. This way, we ensure that our wildlife populations do not decline dramatically.

Mandatory minimum 2-4 Hunters/Fishers per party, 1 vehicle per party

100% of the Kill/Catch is expected to come back to Beaver First Nation to be divvy up amongst BFN Community.
