EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

SUNDAY, MARCH 29th, 2020, Beaver First Nation has entered into a State of Local Emergency (SOLE). Additional measures are now in effect. These measures were developed in order to protect Beaver First Nation Community.

All Members and Residents must stop at checkpoints.

Absolutely NO access to through traffic. RCMP will be called if measure is violated.

THREATS AND NON-COMPLIANCE THAT PUT OTHERS AT RISK WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AND MAY RESULT IN REMOVAL FROM THE BEAVER FIRST NATION RESERVES. RCMP WILL BE NOTIFIED.

Visitors between homes on the Nation are prohibited – Our elders are asking for Protection. Please show respect and think about their wellbeing.

Borders will be heavily restricted. Essential travel and services only. Essential Services include ATCO, Northern Lights, Ambulance, RCMP, Fire Departments, Fuel and Groceries, Authorized Personnel.

Community Members are permitted to leave for employment purposes, essential items (Medical appointments, medication, Groceries). Community members that are required to leave the Nation will be considered infectious and require 10 day self-isolation. The community members homes will be logged and identified through security reports. These homes will be required to take special precautions 10 days after returning to the Nation. The 10 day period will begin each time the member returns to the Nation.

Non-residents will be turned away at the checkpoints unless proper documentation or authorization has been given by the Director of Emergency Management (D.E.M.).

Any Drivers/Operators under the influence of Alcohol or Drugs will be reported to the RCMP. NO EXCEPTIONS!
